MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Meetings are held in the Glen Waverley Community Centre, 700 Waverley Road, Glen Waverley (opposite Allen Street), Melway Map 71 C4/5, usually on the first Friday of the month between February and December at 8.00pm.

Programs include plant commentaries, local and interstate speakers.

- ❖ Topics are varied with emphasis on cultivation techniques.
- ❖ Members display a large variety of cultivated plants on a non-competitive basis.
- ❖ Members provide a plant sales table at monthly meetings.
- ❖ Plant identification and problem solving service available at meetings.
- ❖ A comprehensive library for member use.

The Bulletin, our monthly newsletter, is mailed to members eleven times a year (no January edition). It contains useful advice and informative articles written by members of our Society. Our members mailed *Bulletin* (\$24 within Australia or \$34 overseas) or a full colour Electronic *Bulletin* (\$18 worldwide).

New Members are welcome and encouraged to participate in any of the various group activities organised by the Society.

The **Epiphyte Study Group** and the **Terrestrial Study Group** meet regularly to study epiphytic and terrestrial orchids in detail.

The **Conservation Group** meets regularly to actively preserve our native orchids in their natural habitat.

The **Seed Group** meets regularly to explore cultivation techniques and to raise native orchids from seed.

The **Tuber Bank**, operated by mail, distributes orchid tubers to members at minimal cost.

Social Activities include field trips, shadehouse and glasshouse visits, and weekends away.

The **Annual Spring Show** - Melbourne's finest display of native orchids.

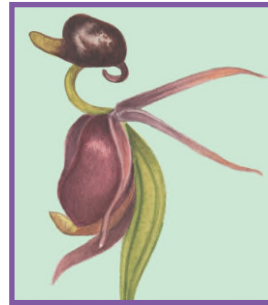

Australia has about 1000 species of native orchids and their habitat is being destroyed at an alarming rate. The Society is dedicated to the conservation of our orchids through cultivation and propagation and also by discouraging the destruction of their habitat and the illegal collection of wild plants.

The Australasian Native Orchid Society is an international body comprising 19 groups in Australia and New Zealand. A.N.O.S. national council produces a quarterly journal, *The Orchadian*, a specialist publication with world-wide circulation. It contains articles of an extremely high standard, including items of scientific and general interest, e.g. cultivation techniques, natural habitats and distribution, name changes and newly described species, conservation and propagation. It also acts as a contact point for other native orchid groups.
