Preparation for the ANOS Vic Members 2026 Tuber Bank is already underway. We invite all terrestrial growers, and in particular, Members who have received tubers in the past, to consider becoming donors. Even small donations can help satisfy the requests for tubers.

Please send a list of tubers (with <u>estimates</u> of numbers) that you expect to be able to supply to the above address, or Email it.

We need your list no later than <u>Monday</u> <u>November 3, 2025</u> so that the lists can be collated and printed in the December <u>Bulletin</u> as an order form. Only species and hybrids nominated by the above deadline can be included in the Tuber Bank listing.

Estimated numbers of tubers are important as these are used to decide in which Group a species will be listed. We understand that it is difficult to estimate what you can donate until you tip the pot out. We anticipate the actual numbers of tubers available for donation may vary considerably from initial estimates, and all we ask is a rough idea of the amount of excess based on how you think the pot will perform.

There is no obligation to supply the numbers pledged if the pot fails to meet expectations. To ensure that virus infections are not spread through the Tuber Bank, we ask that any tubers in doubt are not to donated.

PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE READ

<u>Posting of tubers</u>: The posting of tubers to Kyrill for the Tuber Bank is preferably delayed to mid to late December to avoid any deterioration prior to packing in early January.

Packing of Tubers for Postage:

Experience has indicated that tubers can be damaged during postage, with tubers desiccated from drying out from the packing material, or tubers developing mould due to excess moisture, or being packed tightly in airtight containers. It is a great waste of the tubers and very disappointing if they are damaged and cannot be supplied to Members. The tubers are best packed in a plastic or paper bag for each species and placed in a cardboard box. If the tubers are packed in sphagnum moss, please make sure the moss is not wet.

Please take care in correctly identifying the orchid tubers you are donating.

If in doubt please notify Kyrill.
